Prizes for Journalism Awards 2018 Announced

Lagos, 18 January 2018: Pan African Re/Insurance firm Continental Re has announced prizes for finalists of the 2018 Pan African Re/Insurance Journalism Awards.

- 2. Best Re/Insurance Industry Analysis and Commentary; and

Continental Reinsurance initiated the awards in 2015 to recognise and acknowledge the good work of media on the continent. Journalists were required to demonstrate how their articles raised awareness and understanding of the re/insurance sector in Africa.
